<i>Study programme for which it is organised:</i> the Serbian language and literature								
<i>Connection to other subjects:</i> -								
<i>The subject's objectives:</i> To acquire basic knowledge of structure and functioning of cases in standard Serbian. To acquire basic knowledge of syntactic and semantic features of simple and complex sentences.								
<b>Outcomes (acquired knowledge):</b> The students will acquire structure and types of complex structures in Serbian. They will become familiar with dilemmas regarding methodological approaches to study of complex syntactic structures in general and they will be able to perform different types of analysis (analysis of general characteristics of cases in Serbian in relation to level of integration into sentences structure, analysis of the meaning of prepositions as clarification of cases, and analysis of certain types of complex structures including analysis at the level of a text). All of these will to a great extent prepare them to be professors of the Serbian language in schools.
