Course objectives:

Introduction to language structures in order to gain self-confidence in the pronunciation and accent of Latin words and the morphological analysis of the Latin sentence.

Methods of teaching and acquiring lessons: Lectures and exercises. Colloquia and exam.

Subject content: The teaching process of the subject Latin language I includes a historical overview of the Latin language, a letter, a vocal changes, pronunciation and accent of Latin words, then the morphology of nouns (formation and declension), adjectives (formation, declension and comparison), pronunciation (formation, declension and peculiarities) and verbs (formation, conjugation, and peculiarities in use) in the Latin language of the classical period.
