Study programme for which it is organised: French language and literature

Connection to other subjects: Passed exam from subject Latin language III

Course objectives:

The goal of Latin language IV is to provide students with a good knowledge of the Latin language, enough to understand and translate Latin texts themselves, to independently analyse and interpret syntactic elements in Latin sentences and to answer questions about specific contextual, content and linguistic characteristics of prose texts.

Outcome / results of studying (acquired knowledge): /

Name and surname of a professor and teaching assistant: PhD Slobodanka Prtija, professor.

Methods of teaching and acquiring lessons: Lectures and exercises. Colloquia and exam.

Subject content: During the fourth semester students acquaint and adopt the syntax of Latin independent and dependent sentences and sequence of tenses (consecutio temporum), and deepen the acquired language skills, expand Latin vocabulary and work on more demanding Latin texts.
