The subject's objectives: To improve speaking, reading, writing and listening skills and to acquire technical vocabulary (school and pedagogical terms).

<i>IV week</i>	- <i>Translation of sentences from Serbian into Russian (passive sentence structures)</i>
<i>V week</i>	<i>Interference, help in studying or trick for translating texts</i>
<i>VI week</i>	<i>Participle constructions- active and passive verb adjectives (meaning and translation)</i>
<i>VII week</i>	<i>Verbs of movements: Russian verbs in relation to Serbian verbs,</i>
<i>VIII week</i>	<i>Comparison of adverbs-comparative and superlative, comparison with Serbian comparison</i>
<i>IX week</i>	<i>Colloquium - Translation of text from Russian into Serbian and vice versa</i>
<i>X week</i>	<i>Forming words in Russian-nouns, adjectives, verbs</i>
<i>XI week</i>	<i>Use of indefinite pronouns in sentences</i>
<i>XII week</i>	<i>Analysis of literary text, translation of technical texts in Serbian</i>
<i>XIII week</i>	<i>Prepositions-use in one, two or more cases, meaning of construction with a preposition</i>
<i>XIV week</i>	<i>-preparation for exam, instructions, oral exam</i>
