The subject's objectives: To introduce students to basic laws of psychological life and life cycles; structure, dynamics and development of personality. To enable students to better understand basic concepts and contents in the area of pedagogical psychology with a special focus on behavior of students, and to apply in practice basic psychological knowledge of efficient memory, opinion, learning, skills and transfer of study and problem solving.

Methods of teaching and acquiring lessons: Frontal, group and individual work; workshops and seminars where students are asked to participate and actively engage in class.
