Course objectives:

Developing oral and written expression skills, understanding speech and understanding text, adopting vocabulary, familiarising with the components of everyday French culture. This subject is supplemented by the subject Morphosyntax of the nominal group 1 (grammar exercises, text analysis), and gives students the opportunity to independently present a topic, and adopt a vocabulary related to situations from everyday life. Training students to understand the sentence outside the context and often use terms related to the scope of its core activities.
