#### **Course objectives**

Introduction to the key tenets and prospects of the study of literature. Presentation of different models of theory and method operationalisation. Presentation of exemplary and poorly-written academic papers, with analysis of positive aspects and obvious drawbacks. Different stages of research and alternative approaches to related topics (topic formulation; gathering and selection of sources; paper writing, revision and proofreading).

### Learning outcomes

Ability to identify positive and negative aspects of research papers. Understanding of the process of research paper writing, including the ability to distinguish between different underlying theories, apply their related methods and engage in actual writing. Problem definition and solving. Application of technical guidelines/rules in writing final revisions (reference citation and bibliography formatting; writing of abstracts; etc.). Knowledge of the style/essential linguistic features of academic writing and scientific discourse.

- 2. Philosophical presuppositions of science: definition and origins of concepts
- 3. Scientificity of literature studies: general assumptions
- 4. Theory, methodology and research
- 5. Most common research flaws
- 6. Topic formulation, research materials gathering and selection, and writing of research papers
- 7. Style and essential linguistic features of academic writing
