**Course objectives**

Introduction to the main poststructuralist approaches, their representatives and ideas, goals, methodological principles and results.

**Learning outcomes**

Students acquire the key theoretical tenets and master the main methods of analysis characteristic of specific linguistic approaches.

**Course topics**

Structuralism and its influence on the development of modern linguistic thought: ideas, schools and results. Dependency grammar and valency theory: Meinheim and Leipzig Schools, terminology and aspects of linguistic analysis. Generative grammar: phrase structure theory, X-bar theory, minimalism. Case grammar: Charles Fillmore and the deep case system. Cognitive linguistics: Lakoff and Johnson's metaphor theory, L. Talmy's space and process semantics, R. Langacker's cognitive grammar. Construction grammar: A. Goldberg's theoretical model. Functional grammar: S. Dick's and M.A.K. Halliday's models. Grammaticalisation theory: concepts of grammatical and lexical words, stages of transition from lexicon to grammar, motives for linguistic change.

**Teaching methods and strategies**

Lectures and discussions; analysis and interpretation.
